1. **Nomination cost is \$230 per team (Must supply a referee per team or \$300 without a Referee).** Schools will be invoiced on receipt of team nominations, payment must be received by the close of business on close of business on Tuesday, 21st October 2025.
2. **Team Registration:** To nominate a team, complete the attached team nomination form & email it to admin@swqtouch.com by Friday, 17th October, 2025. Once registration is complete, you will be issued a My Sideline unique Code, which must be forwarded on to parents/players for individual registration. This is the only way players are covered by insurance.
3. Teams are limited to **14 players, only** [max. six (6) on the field]
4. The age and division requirements are:

The divisions offered for the 2025 SWQ Western Conference Primary All Schools Championships will be:

- 4.1 Boys & Girls 10 Years – 10 Years & Under division born in 2015 or after.
- 4.2 BOYS, GIRLS & MIXED DIVISIONS – 12 years and under division born 2013 or after. No students completing Yr7 will be allowed to participate. There is no allowance for any thirteen-year-old.
- 4.3 Teams may nominate players providing they attend the Primary school nominated, are in Year 5 or 6 (12s) and are clearly identified on the registration sheet. If you wish to nominate any 10-year old's completing Year 4 in (12s), approval must first be requested and submitted to the tournament committee prior to nominating. Minimum age for this tournament shall be 9 years, that is, born 2016.
- 4.4 MIXED DIVISION – The maximum number of males allowed on the field of play is three (3). The minimum male requirement on the field of play is one (1).

At the close of nominations, entries for divisions in which there may be insufficient teams for a competition will be notified of the options available to those teams (e.g. combined divisions).

Please note all Primary School divisions will play with a ***junior size 4 ball***.

4. All players shall be bona fide students of the school they represent.
 - 5.1 Each school team should be responsible for obtaining signed forms for **Parental Consent** and **Medical Details**. (These are standard school forms for excursions and sport and they note that parents will accept responsibility for any medical costs).
 - 5.2 Each team must provide their own medical supplies, ice and touch balls. A First Aid Officer will also be available at the fields to treat injuries sustained at the event.
 - 5.3 **Combination of school teams or players**, Schools of less than 150 students may seek to combine with another school of similar size if they cannot fill a team.



Approval must be obtained (in writing/email) from the Tournament Convener prior to nominating.

6. Where schools have more than one team entered:
 - a. Players must only play for one team
 - b. Schools must name their best team as School Name 1 and second team as School Name 2, etc.
5. All **players must be registered to MSL online** to participate in this event. Team contacts are to circulate the MSL Registration Code (generated when the team was registered) for player registration. Please note, online registration must be completed by the parents of players, not team officials. Unregistered players are ineligible to play. Players who are registered must play at least one (1) round game to qualify for the Finals.
6. Teams are to nominate a referee for each team they enter in this tournament. Failure to do so will mean an increased nomination fee. The SWQ referee coordinator will have authority over referees in relation to all tournament matters.
8. All nominated teams / schools must be accompanied by a teacher - or a parent approved by the school's Principal.
10. All teams must wear a numbered uniform, with that number matching the details provided on the registration sheet. Note – Shoes are to be worn at all times. Shoes with screw-in tags or the type with extra high baseball cleats are not allowed. Light leather or synthetic boots with soft molded soles are permitted.
11. Coaches are not permitted to coach or call instructions from behind the scoreline and must remain in the sub box. They may choose to stand at an end of the field, but they must remain silent. This rule applies to all members of a team, including parents, staff, and other team members.
12. Players sent from the field (not a period of time) in a match shall be required to serve a two (2) game penalty with no appeal.
13. Progress to the Final Series is dependent upon the number of playing pools. More detailed information about this will be provided after nominations close and the draw is released.

Points are allocated as follows:

- Win 3
- Draw 2
- Loss 1
- Forfeit 0 (This will also incur a 0 - 5 scoreline)

Where teams are tied for places, the following will apply:

- (a) Result of round game
- (b) Best differential (i.e. for minus against)
- (c) Percentages (i.e. for divided by against, multiplied by 100)



(d) Toss of coin



13.1 All games, including finals will be 2 x 12 minute halves with a 2 minute half time break. (These times may change depending on the number of nominations). There will be no time off for injury.

13.2 In the event of ties in round games, the result shall stand. In the **FINALS SERIES**, all ties shall require a '**drop off**' to be played.

14. Protests / Appeals are to be in written form (using the protest form held in the administration area), clearly stating the game to which the protest relates and specific reasons for the protest. The protest form is to be submitted to the administration area within ten minutes of the completion of the game in question. NB. Protests regarding referee decisions will not be considered.
15. The Tournament Control Committee reserves the right to interpret and amend the above rules as required in the interests of the tournament and its participants. The Tournament Control Committee's decision is final.
16. The Touch Football Australia (TFA 8th Edition) rules shall apply for this tournament.
